The Bedford Heights Community Center Senior/Disabled 2023 Grass Cutting Program



**Registration Fee: \$35 Non-Refundable
Registration Period
Saturday, April 1st – Saturday, April 29th
or limit has been met**

Applications will be distributed and received by the following methods only:

Application-are located in the **gray box** at the community center entrance.

Return completed application with payment in a sealed enveloped via U.S. Mail or insert in black mailbox located outside of the community center.

ELIGIBILITY

The Senior/Disabled Grass Cutting Program is limited to:

1. Seniors age 65 and older, must own and reside at the property. Occupancy Permit will be verified.
2. Disabled adults meeting the federal government criteria. Must show proof of disability.
3. Any Bedford Heights resident whose military spouse has been deployed for active military duty. Must show proof.
4. \$35 Non-Refundable application fee.

Other individuals living in an eligible household must be:

1. Children younger than 12 years of age or disabled.

2. Disabled meeting the federal government disability criteria. Must show proof.

PROGRAM GUIDELINES

- The grass cutting service will provide approximately 20 cuts per season starting mid-May (weather permitting).
- Applicant will be responsible for **maintaining** their grass before the program starts and ends.
- Contractor will cut lawns once a week weather permitting.
- Applicants with fenced in yards must allow contractor access to fenced in area.
- Applicants with fenced in yards must have a 36 inches width opening or larger to allow the lawn mower access.
- This is a basic grass cutting service.
- In the event we run into dry spells, contractors may skip a week at the discretion of the Director of Public Works. Skipped weeks may be added to the backend of the program.

- Program participants are required to report any changes in the household status that would otherwise make them ineligible.

Contractors have the right to refuse to cut lawn if:

- Grass has not been mowed or maintained prior to the start of the program.
- Any large objects left in the yard such as tree limbs, stumps, garden hoses, etc.
- Pets are in the cutting area.

Contractor will not:

- Do any trimming around property.
- Pick up or bag grass clippings.
- Custom cut lawns to individual heights.
- Cut vacant or unoccupied homes.
