Richmond Road Multi-Purpose Trail Project

- The City of Bedford Heights, working in cooperation with the Ohio Department of Transportation (ODOT), will be installing a multi-purpose trail adjacent to the eastern Richmond Road (SR-175) curb line from 1,500 feet north of the Eastern Corporation Line (Bedford Heights/Solon) to Miles Road. The project will consist of the installation of a 10.5' wide concrete multi-purpose trail, curb and driveway apron repairs, utility adjustments and ADA curb ramp upgrades. This project will be administered by ODOT.
- Traffic on Richmond Road will be maintained in both directions during all phases of construction with the assistance of a flagger. All intersections will remain open. Driveways for all properties along Richmond Road will be maintained by either part-width construction or for properties with multiple driveways at least one access driveway will always remain open.
