The Building & Codes department oversees the collection of the Bedford County Schools Facility Privilege Tax. This is a one-time tax charged at \$1 per heated and cooled square foot of new dwellings or bedroom additions in both the unincorporated and incorporated areas within the county. The tax is due within one year of the date of invoice or within 30 days of transfer of title of the property. Privilege taxes have a six-year statute of limitation according to T.C.A 67-1-1501.

This is a notice of uncollectable debt. Every collection effort was made ending with the accounts being sent to a collection attorney. The debtors retained the services of Bobo, Hunt & White to successfully avoid payment of the debt based on the statute of limitations. Therefore, I request the below debt to be written off.
