Borough of Haddonfield Announces \$825,000 Grant Award from NJDOT for Kings Highway Pedestrian Improvements.

Haddonfield – The Borough of Haddonfield has received a \$825,000 grant from the New Jersey Department of Transportation’s Safe Streets to Transit Program to improve pedestrian crossing on Kings Highway. The proposed project focuses on enhancing pedestrian infrastructure on Kings Highway from Haddon Avenue to Washington Avenue, Washington Avenue from Kings Highway to Euclid, and Rosedale Avenue. It represents Phase 1 of Mayor Bianco Bezich's multi-phased project focusing on ADA-compliant curbing and sidewalks, traffic markings and signage, and traffic signals and signage. These improvements are designed to promote safe and accessible pedestrian routes, facilitating easier access to transit and promoting active transportation within Haddonfield. To that end, the project's next phase is intended to address safe routes to the Central and Middle Schools.

Mayor Bianco Bezich, with assistance from the Borough's Special Projects Engineer, Environmental Resolutions, Inc., applied for the grant in the summer of 2024 and received a letter from NJDOT Commissioner Francis O’Conner congratulating the Borough on its award in early December. Mayor Bianco Bezich stated: “This funding from the NJDOT Safe Streets to Transit Program will significantly enhance pedestrian and bicycle safety in Haddonfield, making it easier and safer for residents and visitors to access our local transit options. These improvements will foster a more accessible, connected community. I want to thank Camden County and PATCO for supporting this proposal. We look forward to collaborating to bring the project to fruition.”

A timeline for the start of construction will be announced early in 2025.
