

Safety Committee Minutes

June 13, 2022

- I. Call meeting to order
 - A. Sean called the meeting to order at 11:13 am.
- II. Roll Call
 - A. Present: Jay, Katlyn, Dave, Luke, Rich, Jamie, & Sean
 - B. Absent: Chris Connor
- III. Review of March 2022 Minutes
 - A. Luke made a motion to approve the March 2022 minutes. Katlyn seconded the motion. The motion passed 6-0. Rich abstained.
- IV. Ian's Playground Update
 - A. Rich reviewed each of the findings and provided an update on all.
 - a. The access point to the area needs attention. The pavement is broken and presents a trip hazard. – Rich mentioned that the highway crew filled in the area from the parking lot to the playground with play chips.
 - b. The swings should be replaced. The saddle portion was cracked on most of them presenting pinch points. – Rich said that all 6 swings were replaced. 1 ADA swing, 1 bucket swing, and 4 flat swings.
 - c. The single point swing bearing should be greased for general maintenance. – Rich said the impacted tire swing has been removed.
 - d. The drawbridge bolts should be replaced they were showing signs of wear. – Rich said that he would follow up and make sure that was completed.
 - e. Slide exits need to be 7"-15" above the play surface. – Rich said that additional play chips were purchased and that the drop height was measured and we were in compliance.
- V. Injury at the Town Dock
 - A. Rich shared a Facebook posted from a mother who states that her son was injured after flipping off the Town Dock pier onto the pavement. Rich reported the Facebook post to H/R.
- VI. Proposed Skate Park
 - A. Sean said to keep it on our agenda and let the infrastructure committee know our thoughts. The ideal location would be at Ian's Playground with the ice rink as an alternative site.
- VII. Any New Concerns
 - A. Jamie said the fence at the softball field is missing caps on the top railing down. He said the fence topper should be all the way down the first base line.

- B. Rich suggested covering the holes on the tennis courts with cold patch. Jay said he would have his crew get after it.
- C. Sean said the traffic light is now working the right way as new pedestrian buttons and radars were installed. He said the light isn't delayed as long.
