Tax Due Date – Today was tax due date for the second half of property taxes for the 15/16 year prior to the start of interest accruing. I am pleased to report that as of close of business today, we had collected 89.3 % of the taxes. Thank you to the Bucksport tax payers who have done such a great job of keeping up with their tax payments.

Waterfront Maintenance – Personnel start work next week in getting the waterfront cleaned and spruced up for the coming summer season.

MDOT Bridge Meeting – There will be a meeting with MDOT here in the Council Chambers on Tuesday, April 12<sup>th</sup> at 6 p.m. for the purpose of discussing plans for road/bridge improvements in the Prospect to Bucksport area.

AIM Update – I spoke with Jeff McGlin on Wednesday and he indicated that they were supposed to sign a letter of intent with a new contractor sometime yesterday and that it was anticipated that demolition would re-start within 3 weeks. In addition, he said that the bonding company would be covering payments to vendors of Denovo who had not been paid. They have already heard from a number of them, and if there are any other vendors out there that provided services to Denovo that have not been paid, they should contact Jeff McGlin and he will get the information to the bonding company.
