

MANAGER'S REPORT
June 15, 2017

Friday Program Cancelled – I received a notification that the program scheduled for Friday, June 16th at the Lighthouse Arts Center with the Maine Development Foundation's Main Street has been cancelled due to lack of registrations. Both Brook Minner and I were scheduled to be speakers at that function.

Jay/Livermore Falls Meeting – I have been asked to attend a meeting in Livermore Falls on Monday afternoon, June 19th to discuss what Bucksport has been doing since the closure of the mill. That area is facing a potentially similar fate and is looking for input from communities who are dealing with these issues.

Pool Dedication – The pool dedication as the Tim Emery Municipal Pool will take place at noon on Saturday, June 24th at the pool. Guns N' Hoses will be providing refreshments and we hope that everyone takes a few minutes to come and thank Tim for his efforts.

Gas/Diesel Bids – We opened gas/diesel bids for the 17/18 year yesterday. The awarding of those bids will also be on the agenda for June 22nd. We received bids in line with budget estimations so that is positive for both the Town and the School District since we partner on this bid.
