

MANAGER'S REPORT  
June 8, 2017

Main Street Event – I will be speaking at an event at the Lighthouse Art Studio on Friday, June 16<sup>th</sup> that is sponsored by the Maine Development Foundation. I was asked to speak about Bucksport and its 'story' from the closure of the mill to today. Main Street Bucksport Coordinator Brook Minner is also a speaker at this event. Representatives from Main Street groups all over the state – and communities looking to start such a program – will be in attendance.

AIM Update – Rich Rotella and I met with Jeff McGlenn on Tuesday of this week to discuss progress at the site. Phase II of the deconstruction is essentially complete. The fate of the remaining partially deconstructed buildings will be determined before year end depending on development possibilities that AIM is currently considering. The piles of crushed material are also awaiting distribution depending on where on the site they need to be located to accommodate development.

Pool Dedication – The plan is for the dedication of the Tim Emery Municipal Pool to take place on Saturday, June 24<sup>th</sup>. Guns n' Hoses will be providing hot dogs and drinks for the occasion. The final time for the event on that day will be determined by the beginning of next week.
