Candidate Forum – Town Council - The six Bucksport Town Council candidates are being invited to take part in a Candidates' Forum on Tuesday, Oct. 23, at 6:30 [p.m. in](#) the library at Bucksport High School. The moderator will be Rev. York of the Elm Street Congregational Church, a former member of the Deer-Isle-Stonington School Board. Ge and his wife now reside on Verona Island. The public is invited to attend this session and get to know the candidates that are seeking election to the Bucksport Town Council.

Bids are limited to abutters due to the access issues related to the lot. They are due to be returned by 10/31 and will be on the agenda for Council consideration the first meeting in November.
