

MANAGER'S REPORT

Street Lights – Councilor Carmichael had asked recently about whether Bucksport should look at assuming ownership of its streetlights and changing to LED lighting as has been done in a number of other communities. The communities of Falmouth, South Portland, and Rockland recently collaborated on a program and have developed a 'template' for communities to use when considering this process. I have that information and hope to have that as a Committee discussion item in the near future.

RSU 25 Update – Anthony Wardwell won the State Diving championship recently – for the second year in a row and the Girls Wrestling team also won the State Championship. Congratulations to all of them and I will arrange for them to attend a future Council meeting so that their efforts can be recognized on camera!

Drainage Work – Olver Engineering visited the Woodland Heights/Forest Hills and Main Street areas where we are seeking solutions for drainage issues. The cost estimate for the review and development of some potential solutions is \$5,000. There will be a resolve on the meeting of the 8th to authorize that expenditure.
