Maine Development Foundation Award – The Town of Bucksport and Main Street Bucksport has been selected to receive the 2018 William F. King Jr Downtown Champion Award. The award is being presented at the MDF annual meeting on October 25<sup>th</sup> in Portland.

International Maritime Film Festival – A reminder that the 3<sup>rd</sup> annual International Maritime Film Festival is happening in Bucksport this weekend. There are 16 films being shown and 5 of the film makers will be in Bucksport for the event! Main Street Bucksport is also holding a cider pressing event on Saturday, October 6<sup>th</sup> from 11 a.m. to 1 p.m. on the waterfront near the marina and everyone is encouraged to stop by.

Bucksport YMCA Report – Attached to my report is an update from Bucksport Y Director Nick Tymoczko. The Middle School after school program should be starting after winter vacation and the leadership program in partnership with RSU 25 should begin in late fall. He reports that volunteer recruitment is up significantly this year, that the summer camp program was well attended, that Youth Football is in its first year with the Bucksport Y, that \$300 of bike helmets were distributed at no charge during the summer to children who arrived at the pool without head protection, and that the Bucksport Y has hired a full time membership director to handle in-house registration and other administrative duties.
