Town Office Survey – The Town Office hours survey will go in the mail tomorrow. It is set up in such a way that it can be filled out, refolded and sent back by adding a stamp.

Life Saving Event – Thanks to Bucksport Y employees Maks Grover and Nathan Paulaskas for their efforts at Craigs Pong on August 20<sup>th</sup> to provide lifesaving services to a gentleman who was injured diving into the pond. Their efforts stabilized the situation until emergency medical assistance could arrive.

DEP Complaint – A report was filed with DEP on Wednesday, August 21<sup>st</sup> of foam and an oil sheen in the river near the former mil site. It was also reported on our Facebook page as somehow being related to the Whole Oceans project and to the Bangor Daily News. No report was filed with the Town. Our Code Officer checked with DEP and we learned that a DEP staff person had responded to the complaint and checked the river from the former mill site to the hotel and found nothing of concern. As clarification for anyone who thinks that Whole Oceans is in a construction phase – they are not. The only work being done at the former mill site is related to deconstruction by AIM's contractors and work on the oil pier by Prock Marine.
