Home Meal Delivery Program – The home delivery meal program three days a week continues to be well-used. Last Friday was the highest delivery day so far with 147 meals delivered. I cannot find words to express my thanks to RSU #25 and their kitchen staff for the meal preparation, to Bill Foster for coordinating the program and doing a significant number of deliveries, the loyal volunteer drivers and of course Colleen who takes every call for meal ordering.

Fiscal Year End – The Town Office will be closing at 2 p.m. on Tuesday, June 30<sup>th</sup> to allow staff to complete fiscal year-end closure before we open the doors at 7:30 on July 1<sup>st</sup>. It is advertised in the Enterprise, posted on the doors of the office, and posted on the Town website.

Election Workers – Our Town Clerk has been advertising for Bucksport residents who are interested in serving as election workers for the July 14, 2020 election. The pay rate is \$12 an hour and no experience is necessary.

Y Programs - The Y is rolling out our summer sports clinic sessions for baseball, football, basketball and soccer. There are protocols and guidelines that will be implemented. Dates are July 13<sup>th</sup> to August 20<sup>th</sup> (Monday through Thursday) and the Age group is K-8 (except football is 3-8). Each age group will have their own sessions, in each sport, on the days listed above for 75 minutes each day.
