Board Bootcamp – The Executive Director of the Maine Association of Nonprofits will be holding a board training session for the non-profits that serve the Bucksport area, including HOME CoOp, Northeast Historic Film, Main Street Bucksport, Lighthouse Arts & Education, and WERU. The session will be held on Friday, March 6th at Brown Hall of the Congregational Church and the council members who can make it are asked to attend from 9-10 a.m. In that time there will be a discussion of non-profit basics, some common myths about non-profits, and their important economic and community impact in Maine.
