Make Bucksport Beautiful Day – I would like to have the town sponsor a Make Bucksport Beautiful Day. It would be on May 15<sup>th</sup> (rain date May 16<sup>th</sup>), from 9 a.m. to 12 p.m. and residents would sign up to do roadside cleanup in an area of town that they choose – maybe it is their own neighborhood – maybe it is a favorite walking or hiking area. The Town would supply the trash bags and latex gloves and a coupon for a small soft serve at the Dairy Port for participants. The Public Works crew would pick up the bags on the following Monday. I do not believe the project would cost more than \$1,000 and not only would it help spruce up the community – it is a community building exercise.

Good Morning Program – Thanks to Deputy Chief Winchester and Lilly McCoy of BBHCC, the Good Morning program is set to go for weekly check in calls to seniors who want to participate. At this point they have 15 people who have signed-up to get calls. Volunteers to make the calls are still needed so anyone who might want to help can call the BBHCC to get more information or to sign up. And if you or a relative you know would like to sign up to receive calls – you should call that same number.

Spring Fountain – The last tenant left the Spring Fountain today, via ambulance after Police, Code Enforcement, and Adult Protective visited the facility to try and get the tenant to agree to relocate. The ambulance was called due to the person's deteriorated condition and I am thankful that the visit occurred before it was too late. After seeing the condition of the room, and the person living there – I am thankful to our Code Officer for bringing this action and to the Council for designating it as a dangerous building.

Fishing Pier – The Fishing Pier is under reconstruction! Gardner Concrete has been on site and making good progress.
