TRUCK DRIVER/LABORER

The Town of Bucksport is accepting applications for the position of Truck Driver/Laborer. This is a full time position with health, retirement, and life insurance benefits with overtime required primarily in the winter season.

**Qualifications:**

Minimum of a high school diploma with at least three years of experience operating heavy construction dump trucks, minimum five ton. Must have a Class B driver's license with a clean driving record and must maintain it during the duration of employment with the Town of Bucksport. Applicant must be capable of doing routine maintenance as outlined by the equipment manufacturer and as directed by the Town Mechanic.

**Work Requirements:**

The individual will be required to operate trucks owned or leased by the Town for the purposes of maintaining or constructing Town roads, facilities and infrastructure. All work will be done in an acceptable manner and must be of good quality and compliant with Federal, State, and local safety requirements. The selected employee will be required to do manual labor including but not limited to sewer pipe installation, shoveling, chain saw operation, and heavy lifting when necessary. He/she will be expected to operate all equipment in a professional manner and will avoid any abuse or neglect of the equipment. In addition, the selected employee is required to do other tasks as assigned by the Public Works Director.

**Supervision:**

The selected employee will be supervised by the Public Works Director and in his/her absence by the Shop Mechanic or his/her designee.

**Conditions of Employment:**

Employment will be pursuant to Chapter 2 of the Town Code, Personnel Policies, and any work contract mutually approved by the Town and members of the Highway Department.
