**Re: Butler County Domestic Relations – Reinstatement of Home Investigations**

---

Effective July 27, 2022, Butler County Domestic Relations Court will resume Home Investigations. Home Investigations are ordered to ensure that a parent's residence is safe and that the household is appropriate for the child/children to live or spend time. Home Investigations include onsite home visits, interviews, criminal and traffic record checks of all adult household members and school record check for all minor children involved. In addition, on occasion and as permitted by Court Order, a virtual interview can also be completed as part of the investigation.

More information will be coming soon regarding enrollment in our employment services program. Lastly, plans are also underway to prepare our space to commence supervised parenting time which continues to be suspended. An announcement will be made when these services become available.


