

## **Contempt of Court**

If you are not receiving your court-ordered child support and have an order in Juvenile or Domestic Relations Court, the CSEA can file a "motion to show cause" with the court. The court will serve all parties with notice that the CSEA has filed legal action and the court will hold a hearing to resolve the issue. Since the court cannot go forward without "serving" the required parties, maintaining a current address is extremely important. Please keep us notified of your address, as well as the other party's address, whenever possible.

Failure to appear for a hearing may result in a bench warrant for the party's arrest.
