

Voter Registration

Up to 15th day prior to election:

- Voter may register at an SOS branch, public assistance agency, county or local clerk's office, online or by mail

Starting 14th day prior to election:

- Voter must register **in person** with local clerk with residency verification in order to vote in next election. Mail-in registrants must be notified to apply in person

Election Day:

- Voter must register in person with local clerk with residency verification in order to obtain a ballot for that election

*Residency Verification: current Michigan driver's license/state ID or a utility bill, bank statement, paycheck, government check, other government document reflecting registrant's name and address where they are registering to vote.

Don't forget:

- For in-person voter registration applicants may complete Affidavit of Voter Not in Possession of Photo ID
- Online Voter Registration only available for applicants possessing a Michigan DL or State ID
