### LOCAL "STATE OF EMERGENCY" DECLARATION

TO: Commanding Officer - Michigan State Police Emergency  
Management and Homeland Security Division; District #5  
Coordinator Lt. Ken High

WHEREAS, the novel coronavirus (COVID-19) is a respiratory disease that can result in serious illness or death. It is caused by a new strain of coronavirus that had not been previously identified in humans and can easily spread from person to person.

WHEREAS, COVID-19 has been identified as the cause of an outbreak of respiratory illness first detected in Wuhan City in the Hubei Province of China. Person-to-person spread of the virus has occurred in the United States, with some of those occurring in people with no travel history and no known source of exposure. On January 31, 2020, the United States Department of Health and Human Services Secretary Alex Azar declared a public health emergency for COVID-19, and affected state and local governments have also declared states of emergency.

WHEREAS, the County of Calhoun has been taking proactive steps to prevent and prepare for the spread of this disease.

WHEREAS, the **Chief Elected Official of the Calhoun County Board of Commissioners** has determined that extraordinary measures must be taken to stop the spread of this disease, alleviate the suffering of people, and to protect or rehabilitate property,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT PROCLAIMED BY THE CHIEF ELECTED OFFICIAL BY THE CALHOUN COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS IN ACCORDANCE WITH SECTION 10(b) OF MICHIGAN PUBLIC ACT 390, P.A. 1976 AS AMENDED:

1. That a Local State of Emergency is hereby declared for **Calhoun County**.

2. The Local State of Emergency shall continue for a period of not more than seven days from the date of this declaration unless continued or renewed by the Calhoun County Board of Commissioners.
3. This declaration of a Local State of Emergency shall be given prompt and general publicity and shall be filed promptly with the Michigan State Police Emergency Management Division, Michigan State Police Paw Paw Post, and the Calhoun County Clerk.
4. This declaration of a Local State of Emergency activates the Calhoun Emergency Operations Plan County to direct the jurisdiction's response and recovery efforts and resources so that local resources are being utilized to the fullest possible extent.

This includes activation of the jurisdictions emergency operations center for coordination and control and utilization of the National Incident Management System by disaster relief forces.

5. That this proclamation will take effect immediately from and after issuance.


