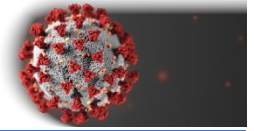

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Cases and deaths declining more sharply, percent positivity decreasing 	<p>Community Case: No evidence of a COVID-19 rebound within the local community. Continued downward trajectory of documented cases within a 14-day period; or, there is a downward trajectory of positive tests as a percent of total tests within a 14-day period (flat or increasing volume of tests).</p>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Healthcare system capacity continues to strengthen 	<p>Health System Capacity Continued rescission of local and state restrictive movement and/or shelter-in-place orders and local and regional health care facilities are able to treat all patients without crisis care.</p>
