

Heretofore, the Chief Judges of the Circuit, Probate and District Courts have certified to the Calhoun County Jury Board the estimated number of jurors necessary for the ensuing juror year which has been based upon the historic practice in each respective court of providing a jury panel for each judge or for the respective court, as applicable. As an operational and financial resource use efficiency, the courts jointly identified the use of a central jury pool as a work element within the 21st Century Commission grant received from the State Court Administrative Office. Due to the number of individual court facilities currently existing, the use of a single jury pool serving all three (3) courts does not appear to constitute any administrative or financial efficiency; however, as a transition to single central jury pool establishment when the courts are moved to the new justice facility in Battle Creek, use of the Circuit Court jury panels to serve not only the Circuit Court but also the juror needs of the District and Probate Court has been identified as having the potential for some improved degree of efficiency.

IT IS ORDERED:

1. Effective October 1, 1993, or as soon thereafter as determined by the Circuit Court Administrator, jury panels established for the Circuit Court shall also constitute juror panels for use by the District and Probate Courts.
2. The Chief Circuit Judge, with the advice of the Chief Judges of the District and Probate Courts, will annually certify to the Calhoun County Jury Board the number of jurors estimated to be needed for service in the Circuit, Probate and District Courts operating under a unified jury pool system.
3. Effective for the remainder of the current juror year, any jurors assigned to use specifically in the District and Probate Courts shall be reassigned to the pool of eligible jurors so long as those jurors have not served as a juror within the past one year within the Circuit, Probate or District Courts.
4. The Circuit Court Administrator, with the advice of the District and Juvenile Court Administrators, will develop a procedure for implementation of this Order coordinating juror use and assignment consistent with the terms of this Order and applicable law. A copy of the procedures shall be filed with the Court Clerk.

This Order shall become effective October 1, 1993.


