
RE: INTER-COURT JUDICIAL ASSISTANCE


This administrative order is issued in accordance with MCR 8.110(3)(a) and (b); MCR 8.110(6) and MCR 8.111;


The Circuit, Probate and District Courts for Calhoun County find there is a need to continue provisions of previous temporary local administrative orders relating to judicial assistance provided between the courts of the county on various matters;

IT IS ORDERED:

1. DJ Case Preliminary Examinations: All DJ case preliminary examinations will be conducted by the District Court Judges acting as judges assigned to the Family Division of Circuit Court.
2. Probate Court Assistance: Should any absence of Judge Jacquette require judicial assistance, the District Judges will provide back up for probate mental proceedings. The Circuit Judges will provide back up for all other Probate matters.
3. Other Judicial Assistance: When agreed to by the Chief Judges of the affected courts, any judge may provide needed judicial assistance to a court for a specific matter or matters under authority of the standing cross assignments made annually by the State Court Administrator.
4. Rescission and Effective Date: This order rescinds local administrative orders C37 2011-11J, D10 2011-09J and P13 2011-07J and is effective April 1, 2012.
