IT IS ORDERED:

This administrative order is issued in accordance with MCR 8.110(D)(2)(a), (b) and (c), effective June 1, 2022, and will continue indefinitely until revised by the Courts and approved by the State Court Administrative Office. The purpose of this order is to coordinate holidays among the Courts and to achieve uniformity with the local funding unit. The previous Administrative Order noted above is rescinded effective May 31, 2022.

The following holidays will be observed by the Courts in Calhoun County:

New Year's Day, January 1;
Martin Luther King, Jr. Day, the third Monday in January in conjunction with the federal holiday;
Presidents' Day, the third Monday in February;
Memorial Day, the last Monday in May;
Juneteenth, June 19
Independence Day, July 4;
Labor Day, the first Monday in September;
Veterans' Day, November 11;
Thanksgiving Day, the fourth Thursday in November;
Friday after Thanksgiving;
Christmas Eve, December 24;
Christmas Day, December 25; and
New Year's Eve, December 31

When New Year's Day, Juneteenth, Independence Day, Veterans' Day, or Christmas Day falls on Saturday, the preceding Friday shall be a holiday. When New Year's Day, Juneteenth, Independence Day, Veterans' Day or Christmas Day falls on Sunday, the following Monday shall be a holiday. When Christmas Eve or New Year's Eve falls on Friday, the preceding Thursday shall be a holiday. When Christmas Eve or New Year's Eve falls on Saturday or Sunday, the preceding Friday shall be a holiday.

The Courts, in accordance with MCR 8.110(D)(2)(c) and to achieve uniformity with the holiday practices of the local funding unit, will also observe the holiday:

Good Friday






Holiday Pay. Section 14.1 of the Collective Bargaining Agreement lists the paid holidays for employees. In accordance with the County Board of Commissioners vote on May 5, 2022, adding Juneteenth (June 19th) and the full day of Good Friday to the recognized county holidays, the Courts will also observe these holidays. A Local Administrative Order has been executed to formalize the new holidays. Section 14.1(A) of the Agreement will now read:

President's Day (Third Monday in February)
Good Friday
Memorial Day (Last Monday in May)
Juneteenth (June 19th)
Independence Day
Labor Day (First Monday in September)
Veteran's Day

Friday after Thanksgiving
Christmas Eve
Christmas Day
