Notice is hereby given that a Special Election will be held in Burlington Township on Tuesday, May 7, 2019. The polls of said election will be open at 7 o'clock a.m. and will remain open until 8 o'clock p.m. on Election Day at the following location:

Please take notice that the Village of Burlington will be voting on the following millage proposal as presented and listed below:

### **VILLAGE OF BURLINGTON** PROPOSAL TO RESTORE AUTHORIZED OPERATING MILLAGE

Shall the authorized millage for the Village of Burlington, established at 12.5 mills (\$12.50 per \$1,000 of taxable value) and reduced to 9.8043 mills (\$9.8043 per \$1,000 of taxable value) by the required millage rollbacks, be increased and restored to the original authorized millage of 12.5 mills (\$12.50 per \$1,000 of taxable value), to provide funds for general operating purposes, which 2.6957 mills increase will raise an estimated \$8,899.96 in the first year the millage is levied?

Absentee ballots are available for all elections; registered voters may contact the Burlington Township clerk to obtain an application for an absent voter ballot.

To comply with the Help America Vote Act (HAVA), voting instructions will be available in audio format and in Braille. Arrangements for obtaining the instructions in these alternative formats can be made by contacting your township clerk in advance of the election. All polling locations are accessible for voters with disabilities.
