

**NOTICE OF REGISTRATION
FOR THE ELECTION TO BE HELD ON TUESDAY, MAY 7, 2019
BURLINGTON VILLAGE, MICHIGAN**

To the qualified electors of the Village of Burlington, County of Calhoun, State of Michigan:

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that any qualified elector of Burlington Village who is not already registered, may register to vote at the office of the Township Clerk; the Office of the County Clerk; a Secretary of State branch office, or other designated state agency. Registration forms can be obtained at www.mi.gov/vote and mailed to the Township Clerk. Voters who are already registered may update their registration at www.expressSOS.com.

The last day to register in any manner other than in-person with the local clerk is **Monday, April 22, 2019**.

After this date, anyone who qualifies as an elector may register to vote in person with proof of residency (MCL 168.492) at the Burlington Township Clerk's office, located at the Township Hall, 135 Elm Street, PO Box 69, Burlington, at the following times:

Office open Saturday, May 4th from 7:00 a.m. – 3:00 p.m.
Election Day Hours: 7:00 a.m. – 8:00 p.m.

Qualifications for registration: each individual must be a citizen of the United States; not less than 17½ years of age; a resident of this state; and a resident of the township. (MCL 168.492 amended).

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that the Village of Burlington will be voting on the following millage proposal as presented and listed below:

**VILLAGE OF BURLINGTON
PROPOSAL TO RESTORE AUTHORIZED OPERATING MILLAGE**

Shall the authorized millage for the Village of Burlington, established at 12.5 mills (\$12.50 per \$1,000 of taxable value) and reduced to 9.8043 mills (\$9.8043 per \$1,000 of taxable value) by the required millage rollbacks, be increased and restored to the original authorized millage of 12.5 mills (\$12.50 per \$1,000 of taxable value), to provide funds for general operating purposes, which 2.6957 mills increase will raise an estimated \$8,899.96 in the first year the millage is levied?
