

# NOTICE OF REGISTRATION FOR THE ELECTION TO BE HELD ON TUESDAY, AUGUST 6, 2019

To the qualified electors of **CLARENCE TOWNSHIP**  
in the County of Calhoun, State of Michigan:

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that any qualified elector of Calhoun County in the Township of Clarence who is not already registered, may register to vote at the office of the Township Clerk; the office of the County Clerk; a Secretary of State branch office, or other designated state agency. Registration forms can be obtained at [www.mi.gov/vote](http://www.mi.gov/vote) and mailed to the Township Clerk. Voters who are already registered may update their registration at [www.expressSOS.com](http://www.expressSOS.com).

The last day to register in any manner other than in-person with the local clerk is **MONDAY, JULY 22, 2019**.

After this date, anyone who qualifies as an elector may register to vote in person with proof of residency (MCL 168.492) at the Township Clerk's office at the following times:

Qualifications for registration - each individual must be: a resident of Michigan and the city or township where you are applying to register to vote for at least 30 days before election day; a citizen of the United States of America; at least 18 years of age (by election day); and not serving a sentence in jail or prison. (MCL 168.492 amended).

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that the Township will be voting on the following proposal:

## **CLARENCE TOWNSHIP** OPERATING MILLAGE RENEWAL PROPOSAL

Shall the limitations on general ad valorem taxes under Article IX, Section 6 of the Michigan Constitution now reduced from the allocated one (1.0000) mill to 0.7948 mill for said township be increased by .02052 mills (\$0.2052 per \$1,000 for taxable value) to renew and restore to one (1.0000) mill to be levied from 2019 in perpetuity for general operating purposes; and shall the township levy such increase in millage for said purpose, thereby raising the first year an estimated additional \$16,425 (this is a renewal of the allocated operating Millage)?
