

NOTICE OF REGISTRATION FOR THE ELECTION TO BE HELD ON TUESDAY, AUGUST 6, 2019

To the qualified electors of **SHERIDAN TOWNSHIP**
in the County of Calhoun, State of Michigan:

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that any qualified elector of Calhoun County in the Township of Sheridan who is not already registered, may register to vote at the office of the Township Clerk; the office of the County Clerk; a Secretary of State branch office, or other designated state agency. Registration forms can be obtained at www.mi.gov/vote and mailed to the Township Clerk. Voters who are already registered may update their registration at www.expressSOS.com.

The last day to register in any manner other than in-person with the local clerk is **MONDAY, JULY 22, 2019**.

After this date, anyone who qualifies as an elector may register to vote in person with proof of residency (MCL 168.492) at the Township Clerk's office at the following times:

Qualifications for registration - each individual must be: a resident of Michigan and the city or township where you are applying to register to vote for at least 30 days before election day; a citizen of the United States of America; at least 18 years of age (by election day); and not serving a sentence in jail or prison. (MCL 168.492 amended).

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that the Township will be voting on the following proposal:

SHERIDAN TOWNSHIP ROAD MILLAGE PROPOSAL

Shall Sheridan Township impose an increase of up to 1.0 mills (\$1.00 per \$1,000 of taxable value) in the tax limitation imposed under Article IX, Sec. 6 of the Michigan Constitution and levy it for 3 years, 2019 through 2021, inclusive for local road repairs, upgrades, construction, improvement and maintenance purposes, which 1.0 mill increase will raise an estimated \$45,300 in the first year the millage is levied?
