MI-SUVI Rank
Calhoun County is the 14th most vulnerable county (out of 83) in Michigan with regards to substance use, with a MI-SUVI score worse than the county average.

Burden Rank
Calhoun County ranks 3rd in substance use burden in Michigan, with a composite burden score worse than the county average.

Resources Rank
Calhoun County ranks 16th in substance use resources in Michigan, with a composite resource score better than the county average.

Social Vuln. Rank
Calhoun County ranks 23rd in social vulnerability in Michigan, with a composite social vulnerability score worse than the county average.

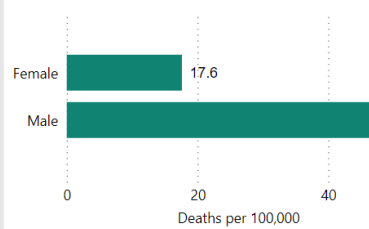

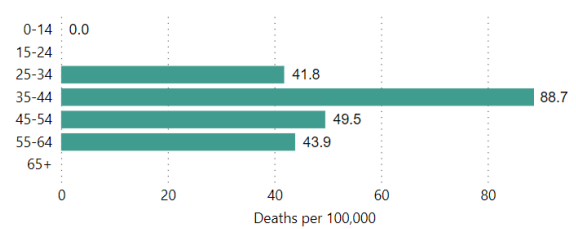

Rate by Sex Assigned at Birth

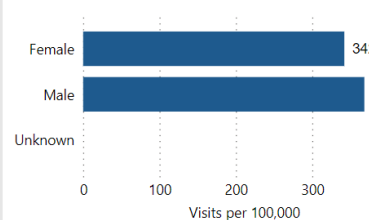


Rate by Age Group

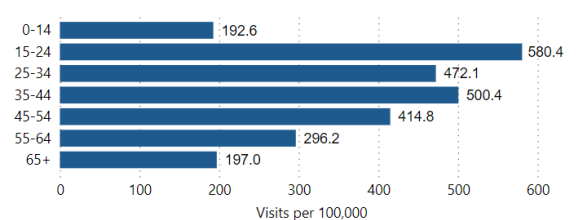

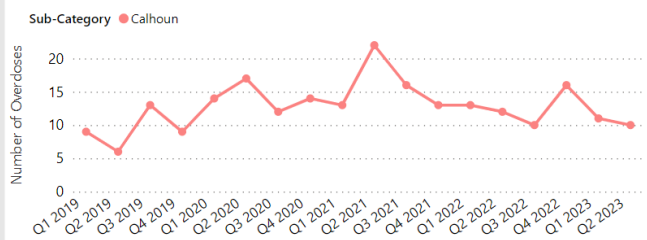

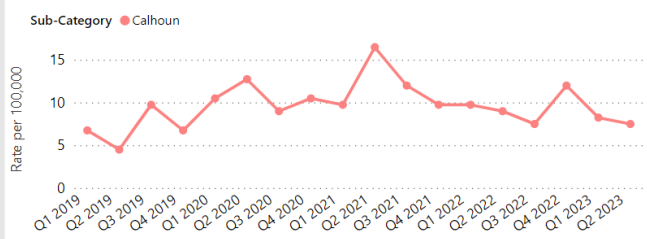

EMS Rates Not Calculated

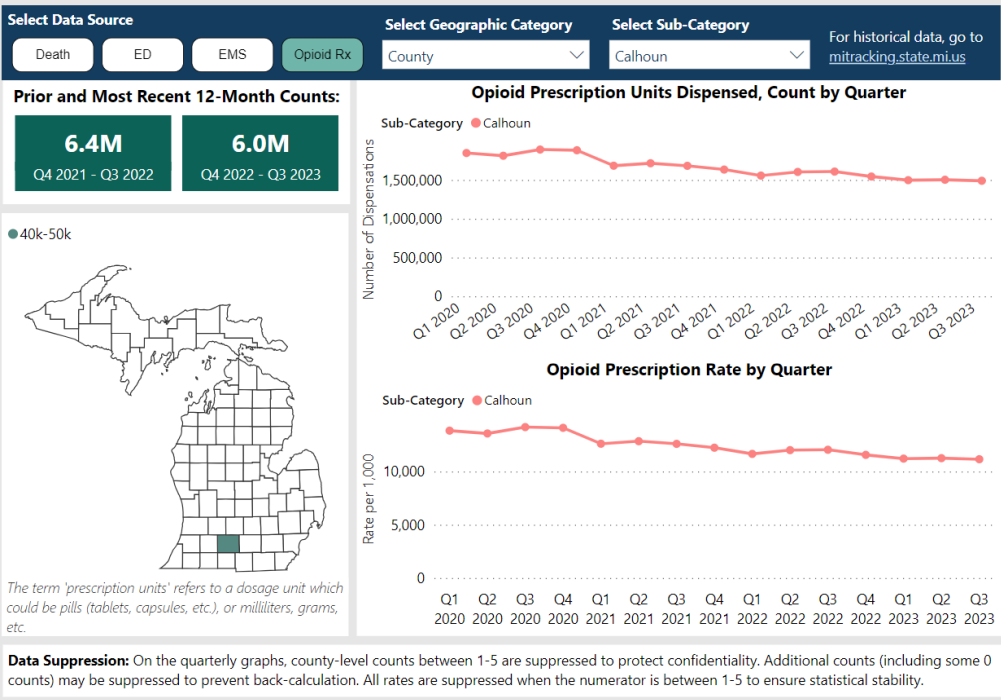
