### **Calhoun County Public Health Department Offer Walk-In Vaccine Clinic**

**Battle Creek MI**, The Calhoun County Public Health Department (CCPHD) is offering COVID-19 walk-in Pfizer vaccine clinics this week for adults ages 16 and older. Clinics will be held in Battle Creek and Marshall.

#### **Battle Creek**

Battle Creek Clinics for Pfizer vaccine will take place on Tuesday (4/20), Wednesday (4/21), and Friday (4/23) at the YMCA Multi Sports Complex. The Pfizer vaccine is available for adults age 16+. Individuals who are 16 or 17 must be accompanied by a parent or legal guardian to receive the vaccine. The second dose clinic will take place three weeks later on Thursday, May 13, 2021.

These walk-in clinics will be held at 86 Cherry St., Battle Creek, MI at the Battle Creek YMCA Multi Sports Complex at the hours listed below:

- Tuesday, April 20, 9:00 a.m.-2:00 p.m.
- Wednesday, April 21, 2:00 p.m.-7:00 p.m.
- Friday, April 23, 9:00 a.m.-2:00 p.m.

#### **Marshall**

On Saturday, April 24 from 9:00 a.m. – 2:30 p.m., the CCPHD will be holding a drive-thru vaccine clinic at the Calhoun County Fairgrounds, 720 Fair St., Marshall, MI. No appointments needed to attend the drive-thru clinic. The second dose clinic will take place three weeks later on Saturday, May 15, 2021.

At all walk-in clinics, individuals with an existing scheduled appointment will be prioritized. Keep in mind, wait times will be contingent on the number of individuals present for vaccine. The health department has plenty of vaccine available for those who will attend the walk-in clinics and does not require individuals to arrive “hours” before the clinic opens to receive the vaccine.

The Calhoun County Public Health Department continues to see a significant increase in COVID-19 cases in our community. The Health Department urges all eligible adults to get vaccinated with whatever vaccine that is available and most convenient for them.
