School Wellness Program (SWP)

Glomski, School Wellness Program Manager, presented an overview of the CCPHD Student Health Center-awarded American Public Health Association "A Program to Improve Graduation by Integrating Public Health Prevention and Primary Care in Schools". The program consists of coordination between Battle Creek Central High School (BCCHS) and the Student Health Center "to develop and implement public health strategies school-wide to improve the well-being and educational success of all students."

Finance Update

Johnson presented the FYE 17 Preliminary Financial Report. The report included:

- Activity through September 30, 2017 indicates that at 2016-2017 Fiscal year-end, revenue and expenditures balance and are within expectation levels based on a 3-year expenditure average

Hepatitis A Update

Pessell presented a Hepatitis A update. The update included:

- Five Hepatitis A cases identified in Calhoun County
- Fourteen additional clinics have been organized with approximately 800 individuals immunized
- Continue efforts to schedule clinics at area feeding sites and soup kitchens
- The CCPHD response team participates in multiples state phone calls along with the 15 jurisdictions
- The Hepatitis A outbreak is known as the largest outbreak in the country
- Hospitals participating in vaccinating staff and target population
- State funding was received for response efforts

Health Officer's Report

Pessell presented the Health Officer report. The report included:

- Environmental Health office renovations complete
- Pessell is on the Statewide Sanitary Code committee to develop an onsite wastewater code
