## EXAMPLES OF ACCEPTABLE PROOF OF IDENTIFICATION

*You must bring in **one** proof of identification for you and any infant or child who is applying for WIC. The document must be current. Any one of these items can be proof of identity:*

- Baptismal certificate
- Birth certificate
- Client's school ID or record, recent
- Court orders (divorce, child support, alimony, adoption)
- Driver's license
- Foster child placement letter/notice
- ID card for health, social services, or work
- Infant hospital records (ex: crib card, discharge papers). Acceptable for infants only.
- Immigration record
- Marriage license
- Medical records
- U.S. Military ID
- U.S. Passport
- Paycheck/stub with name
- Official photo ID card
- Supplemental security income letter in applicant's or client's name
- Unemployment documents in applicant's or client's name
- Social security card
- Immunization record

## EXAMPLES OF ACCEPTABLE PROOF OF MICHIGAN RESIDENCY

*You must bring in **one** of the following as proof of your Michigan residency. The document must be current and show your name and physical address (P.O. Box address not accepted).*

*Note: Women and children can qualify for WIC regardless of their citizenship or immigration status.*

- Utility bill (ex: electric or phone bill)
- Bank statement
- Client's school record, recent
- Driver's license
- Foster child placement/notice
- Housing, rent/mortgage agreement
- Letter from person applicant lives with and proof (ex: utility bill) with the name/address of the individual with whom the applicant or client is living
- U.S. military orders
- Official map/residence location
- Paycheck/stub with name and address
- Official photo ID card
- Shelter letter signed/dated by staff
- Property tax receipt, W-2 form for the previous year (can only be used in January or February of the current year)
- Unemployment documents in the applicant's or client's name
- Voter registration card
