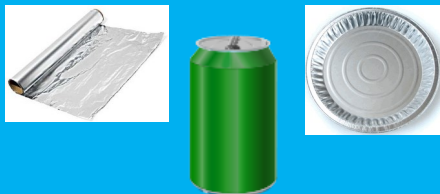

- Plastic bags (return to stores)
- Plastic film (shrink wrap)
- Electronics
- Appliances
- Tires
- CFL or fluorescent tube light bulbs
- Carpet and padding
- Furniture
- Window glass, auto glass, or mirrors
- Dishware or ceramics
- Scrap metal
- Bio-Hazardous Waste/Medical Waste (masks & gloves)
- Paper towels, tissues, or paper plates
- Receipts
- Straws and plastic silverware

Recyclers must wear a mask and remain in their vehicle while their vehicle is unloaded. All recycling must be placed in the farthest position available in your vehicle (trunk area or truck bed). Recycling needs to be sorted and placed inside a non-returnable container at this time. Each visit is limited to items that would fill a 96-gallon curbside cart.

**C&C Landfill Recycling Center Program**

Calhoun County residents, who are not served by a single hauler recycling contract, may pick up a pass from their city, village, or township offices which will entitle them to bring a load of recycling equivalent to a 96-gallon curbside cart to the landfill recycling center for free each visit. Program is limited to residential recycling and participants must show pass to scale attendant at landfill. This recycling center is single stream and requires no sorting.
