

RESOLUTION NO. 2021-12-13-2

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CAMILLA REAFFIRMING THE EXISTING ELECTION DISTRICTS; REPEALING ALL RESOLUTIONS IN CONFLICT HEREWITH; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the City of Camilla elects members to the City Council from two election districts; and

WHEREAS, members are elected from Post 1, Post 2, and Post 3 from each respective district; and

WHEREAS, in order to comply with the United States Supreme Court decision and all the laws and regulations promulgated by the United States Justice Department it is necessary to maintain the population of the election districts relatively equal; and

WHEREAS, the accepted deviation of the United States Justice Department and the Office of Legislative Reapportionment for the State of Georgia, the standard deviation can be no more than five percent from the ideal population in a district; and

WHEREAS, after the decennial census, the City of Camilla did receive assistance from the Reapportionment Office as created by the Georgia General Assembly; and

WHEREAS, the districts as presently constituted show a deviation of two percent or less for each district; and

WHEREAS, after careful study and deliberation, the Mayor and City Council have determined that the districts as currently drawn meet the requirements of the United States Justice Department; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Council have determined that reaffirming the current election districts would be less disruptive to the election process in Camilla and prevent confusion by certain electors who would be required to change election districts unnecessarily.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Camilla as follows:

Section 1. The election districts as currently constituted in the City of Camilla are found to be in reasonable compliance with the concept of one man one vote and within the deviation utilized by the United States Justice Department to comply with this requirement.


Section 2. The current election districts attached hereto as “Exhibit A”, together with the population summary of District 1 at 2,542 and a deviation of -2.00% and the population of District 2 at 2,645 and a deviation of 1.97%, are hereby reaffirmed

by the Mayor and City Council and shall be used for elections to the Camilla City Council and shall remain in place until changed by the Mayor and Council by the adoption of an ordinance utilizing procedures in O.C.G.A. §36-35-4.1.


Section 3. All resolutions or parts of resolutions in conflict herewith are repealed.

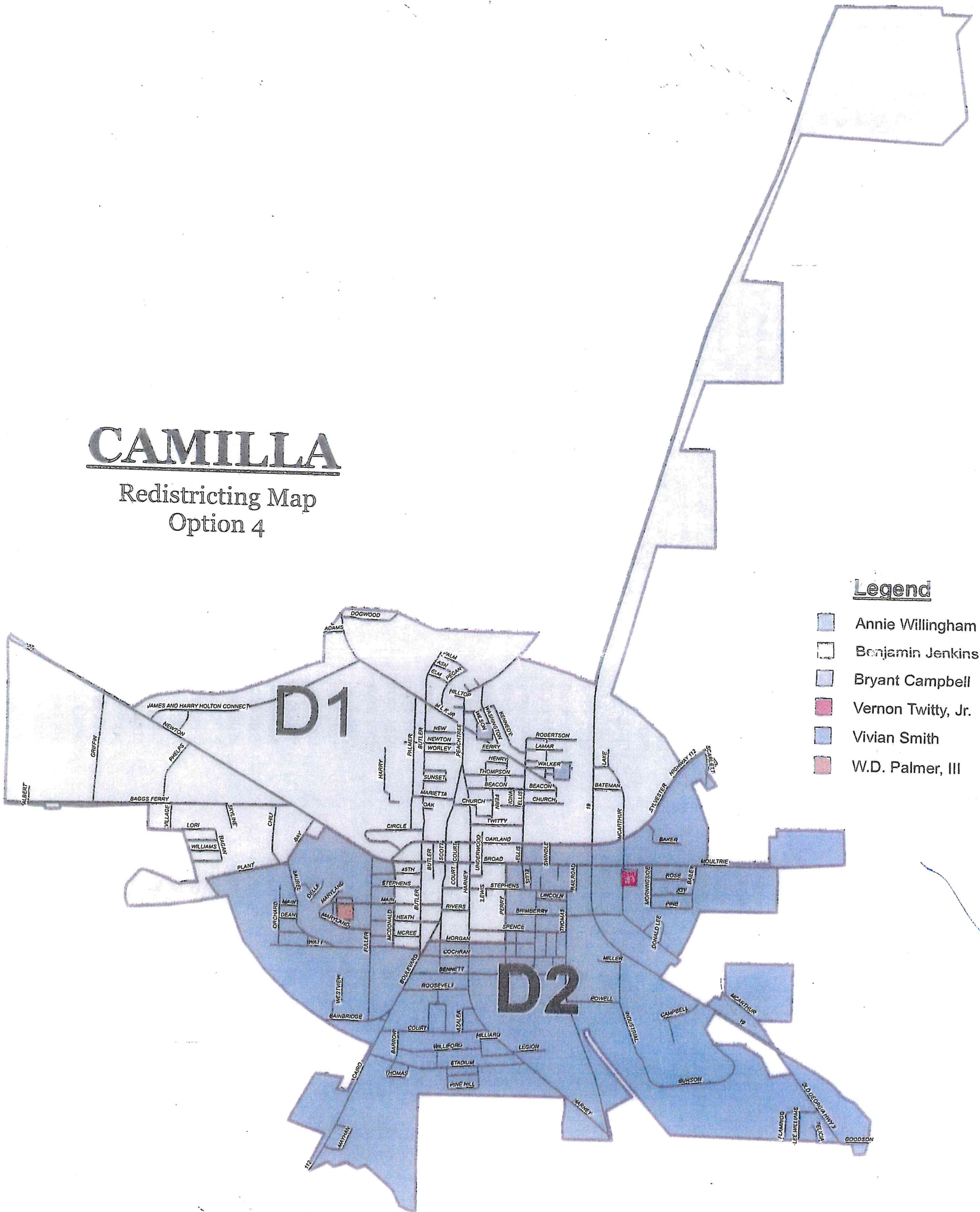
