RESOLUTION NO. 2013-07-08-1

A RESOLUTION CALLING ON ALL CITIZENS OF THE CITY OF CAMILLA TO CEASE AND DESIST IN WEARING SAGGY PANTS; REQUESTING PARENTS AND OTHERS WHO WORK WITH YOUNG PEOPLE TO TAKE WHATEVER REASONABLE MEANS POSSIBLE TO PREVENT YOUNG PEOPLE UNDER THEIR CONTROL FROM WEARING SAGGY PANTS; CALLING ON BUSINESSES AND ESTABLISHMENTS TO POST NO SAGGY PANTS SIGNS; REPEALING ALL RESOLUTIONS IN CONFLICT HERewith; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Council of the City of Camilla have observed certain citizens of the City wearing saggy, baggy pants; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Council find this form of dress offensive and inappropriate; and

WHEREAS, after careful study and consideration the Mayor and City Council have determined that the wearing of saggy, baggy pants facilitates the threat of crimes; and

WHEREAS, after careful study and consideration it has been determined that saggy, baggy pants is injurious to the health of the wearer;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Camilla as follows:

Section 1. The wearing of saggy, baggy pants showing a person's undergarments is offensive to the public morals of the City of Camilla.

Section 2. Parents, community leaders, church leaders, school leaders, and others who are in direct contact and supervision of young people are encouraged to do whatever is reasonably possible to prevent the wearing of saggy, baggy pants in the City of Camilla.

Section 3. The owners and operators of businesses and establishments in the City of Camilla are requested to post signs saying "No saggy pants" in the City of Camilla and are requested to refuse service to anyone improperly dressed by wearing saggy and baggy pants in their business or establishment.

Section 4. All resolutions or parts of resolutions in conflict herewith are repealed.
