As a volunteer at the Carbon County Animal Shelter, I understand:

- * I am 18 years or age or older.
- * I must follow rules and directions at all times. Volunteers will work under the direction of a shelter employee at all times.
- * I am here to assist the staff and my volunteering is on a discretionary / as needed basis.
- * All dogs need to be treated with compassion and respect.
- * Some dogs are not ready to be around volunteers.
- * A dog may bite at any time.
- * Only staff can remove or put a dog in a kennel.
- * No one other than staff is to be in a kennel with a dog.
- * Fingers/hands are not to be put in the kennel with a dog.
- * Some days I may not have contact with a dog.
- * All visitors' questions must be answered by the staff. (Volunteers do not answer phone).
- * When I walk a dog, I need to keep the dog away from other dogs and visitors.
- * When returning from a walk, I need to wait outside the door until a staff member takes the dog.
- * Volunteers will be excused for missing a scheduled work commitment if you call the shelter to notify us at least 1 hour in advance. You will no longer be scheduled if you miss 2 shifts without calling.
- * There is no guarantee that work will be available if a volunteer shows up unexpectedly. To avoid being turned away, please call ahead.
- * A maximum of 4 volunteers will be allowed in the shelter at one time. (2 walkers, 2 cleaners)
- * Volunteers are NOT permitted to administer medication or medical care to any dog. Notify shelter employees immediately about any medical concerns.
- * Volunteers may not represent themselves as agents of Carbon County Animal Shelter
- * No one is permitted on the shelter premises when a shelter employee is not present
- * Volunteers are needed and appreciated, but the Carbon County Animal Shelter reserves the right to restrict access to the shelter when we feel it is in the best interest of the facility.
