

It was approved on a 7-2-2-0. Vote. Voting yes were Councilors Vidot, Tejada, Rodriguez, Murphy, Lopez, Robinson, and Garcia. Voting no were Councilors Cortell and Frank. Councilors Avellaneda and Recuperero were absent.
