A moment of silence was held for the passing of Former Police officer Jack Phillips

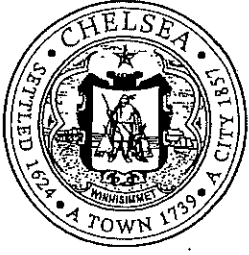
