The Senior member Leo Robinson opened nominations for President. Councilor Taylor nominated Councilor Robinson. The motion was seconded by Councilor Vidot. Councilor J. Garcia nominated Councilor Brown. Seconded by Councilor Vega Maldonado. Councilor Brown requested that nominations be closed. A roll call was taken and Councilor Robinson received 6 votes Councilor Brown received 5 votes. The clerk announced that Councilor Robinson was the new President for the year 2023. Voting for Councilor Robinson were Councilors Lopez, Robinson, Recupero, Vidot, Hatleberg and Taylor. Voting for Councilor Brown were Councilors

Brown, J. Garcia, T. Garcia, DeJesus, and Vega Maldonado. City Clerk Jeannette Cintron White administered the oath of office.

Councilor Robinson thanked everyone, gave brief remarks and then proceeded with nominations for Vice-President. Councilor Lopez nominated Councilor Recupero. Seconded by Councilor Vidot. Councilor Brown nominated Councilor DeJesus seconded by Councilor Vega Maldonado. Closed by President Robinson. On roll call Councilor Recupero received 7 votes Councilor DeJesus received 4 Votes. The Clerk announced that Councilor Recupero would be the Vice President for 2023. City Clerk Jeannette Cintron White administered the oath of office.

Council President Robinson opened nominations for Delegate to the School Committee. Councilor Recupero nominated Councilor T. Garcia. Councilor Brown seconded the nomination. Councilor Taylor moved that the seating arrangement taken at the December 19, 2022 Conference be the seating arrangement for the 2023. Adopted by roll call 11-0-0-0. Voting yes were Councilors Brown, J. Garcia, T. Garcia, Lopez, Robinson, Recupero, Vidot, DeJesus, Hatleberg, Vega Maldonado, and Taylor.

Councilor T. Garcia moved that the Roll Call positions be the roll call positions as drawn at the December 19, 2022 Conference. Adopted by roll call 11-0-0-0. Voting yes were Councilors Brown, J. Garcia, T. Garcia, Lopez, Robinson, Vidot, DeJesus, Hatleberg, Vega Maldonado, and Taylor.

Councilor Vidot moved that the Rules and Regulations for the year 2022 be the Rules and Regulations for the year 2023 until such time that the Rules Committee introduced rule changes and updates. Adopted by roll call 11-0-0-0. Voting yes were Councilors Brown, J. Garcia, Lopez, Robinson, Recupero, Vidot, DeJesus, Hatleberg, Vega Maldonado and Taylor.

The meeting adjourned at 7:30 p.m.
