Item #1 – Approval of the minutes from the October 6, 2020 meeting.

Item #2 – Communication of July 22, 2020, from Louie Gonzalez of Chelsea Prospers, requesting the approval of site plans for permanent outdoor seating parklets of four restaurants in the downtown area through November 1, 2020 due to the Covid-19 pandemic. \*Commission to review the results of the thirty day pilot program extension for Tijuana's Restaurant that was approved on September 8, 2020.

Item #3 – Communication of September 14, 2020 from Councilor Recupero, requesting the Commission to look into removing the one-way sign between Essex Street, Shurtleff Street and Congress Avenue.
