



Licensing Your Dog

All dogs over the age of 6 months must be licensed by the City Clerk's Office, and licenses must be renewed each year (April 1st – March 31st)

To receive a license, please bring your dog's current rabies certificate to the City Clerk's Office.

The cost of the license is between \$15 and \$20, depending on gender and spaying.

\$50 FINE FOR AN UNLICENSED DOG.

Walking Your Dog

All dogs must be leashed at all times within the city. (*Chelsea Code of Ordinances, Chapter 4, Sections 4-48 and 4-49.*)
