

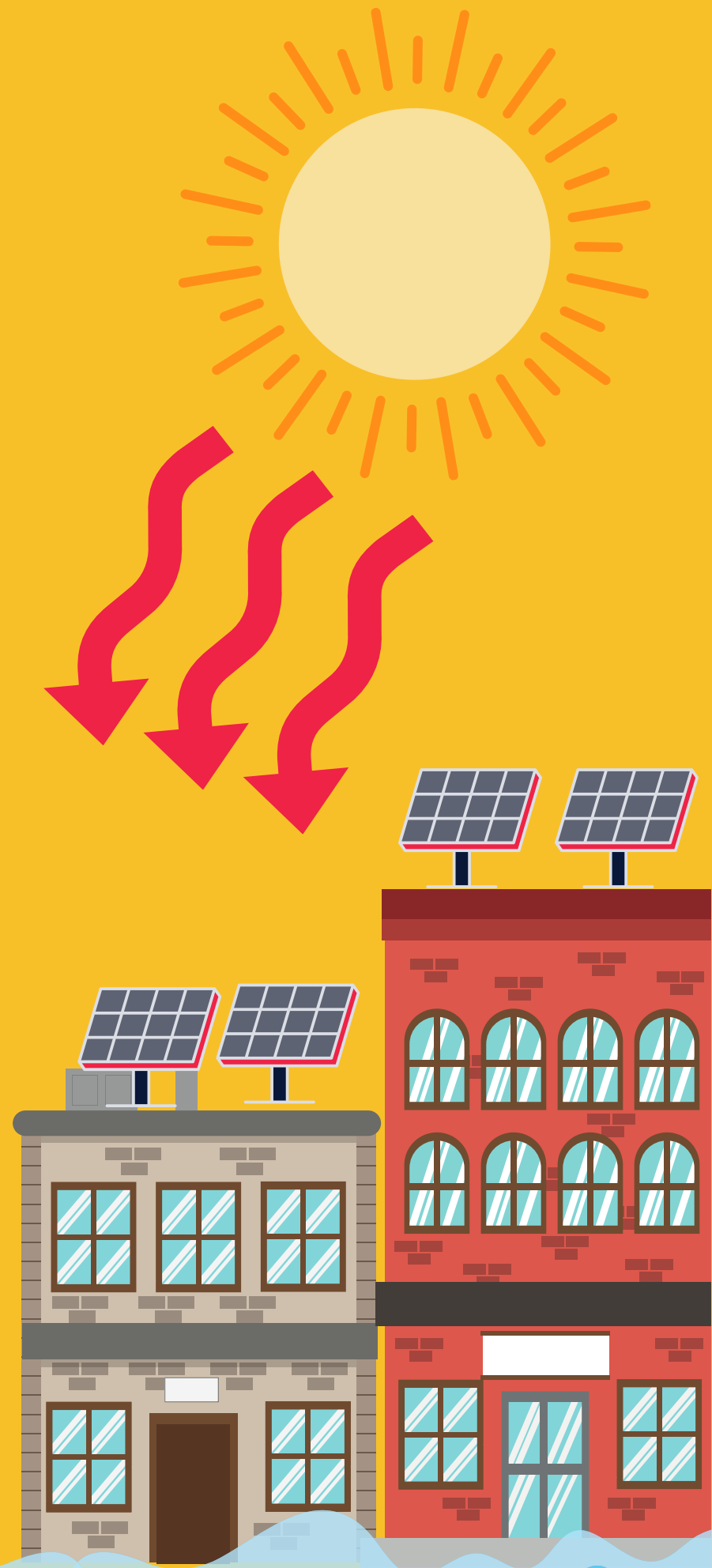

Flooding & Extreme Temps

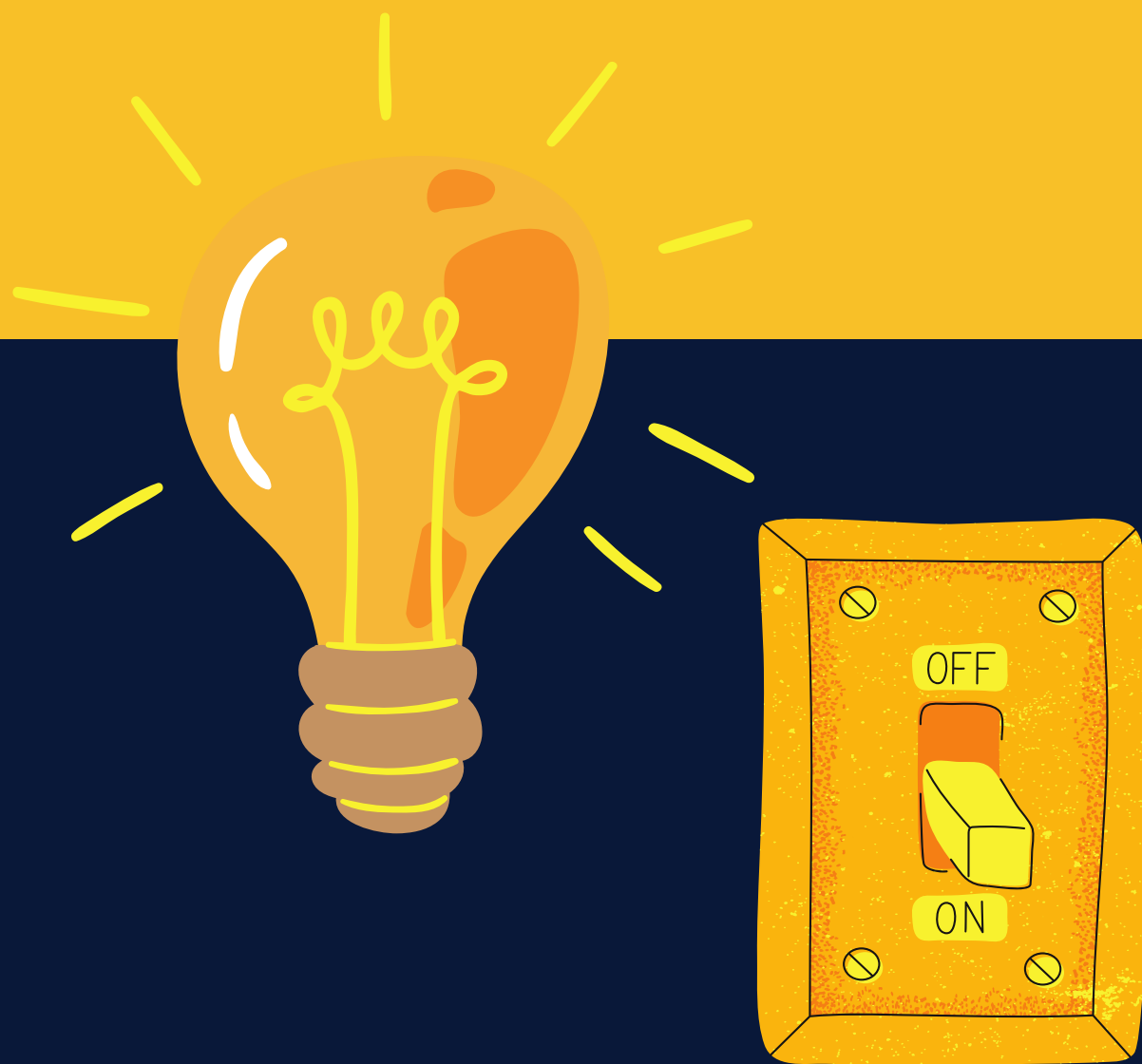
We know climate change causes extreme weather, for example, severe storms, floods, and heat waves that will happen more often. Chelsea is at risk!

services remain operable.

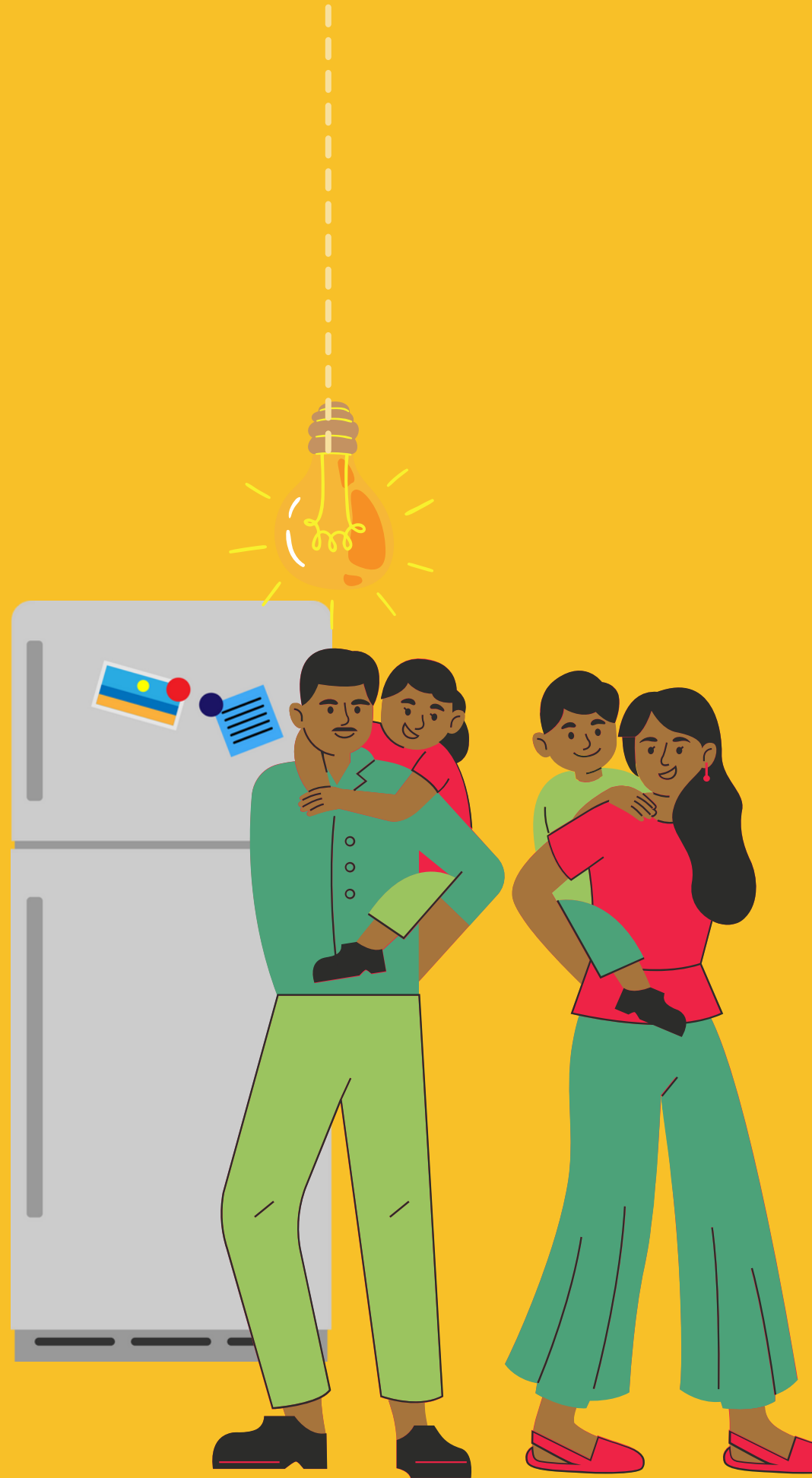


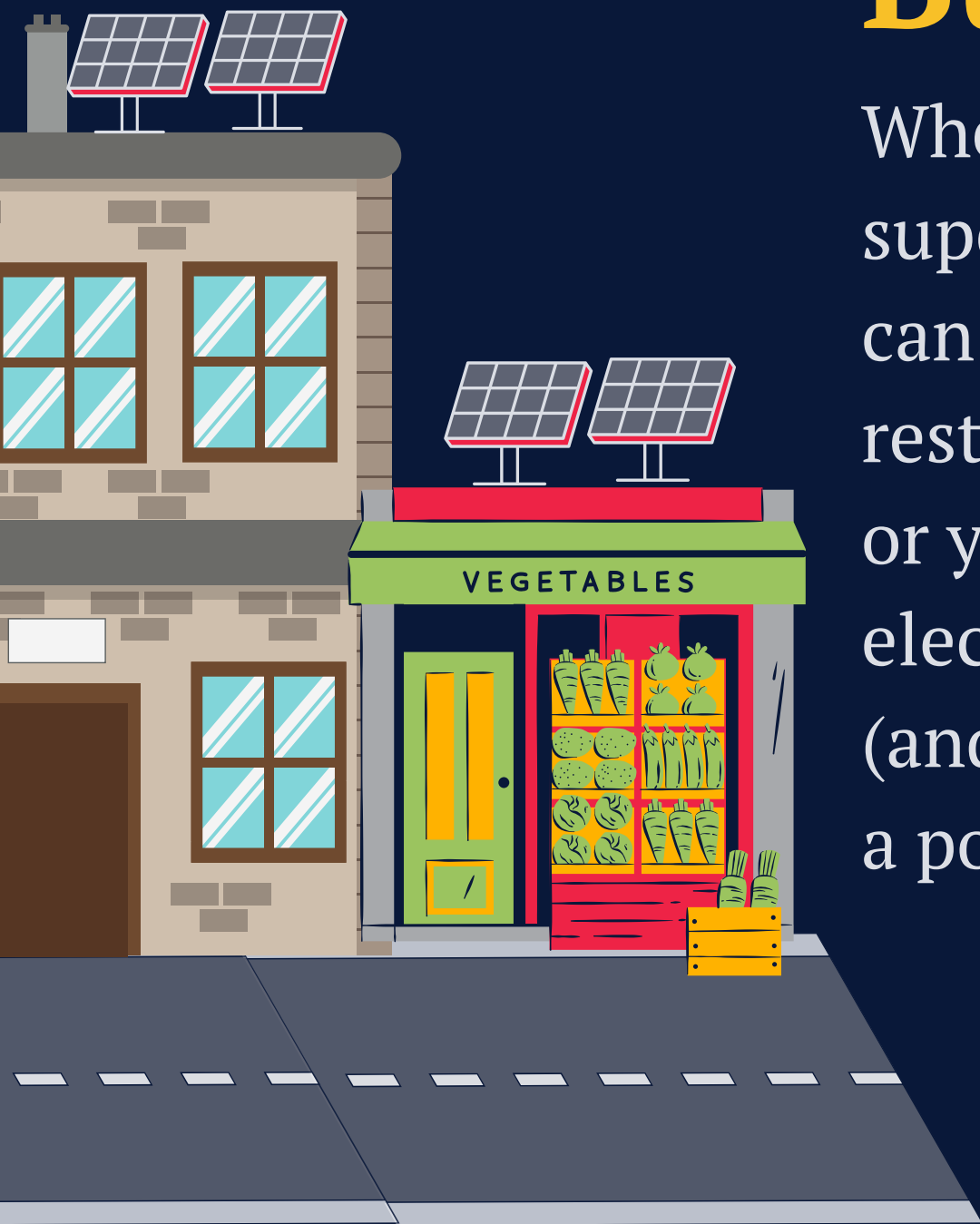
Your Home

Personal medical equipment continues to work.

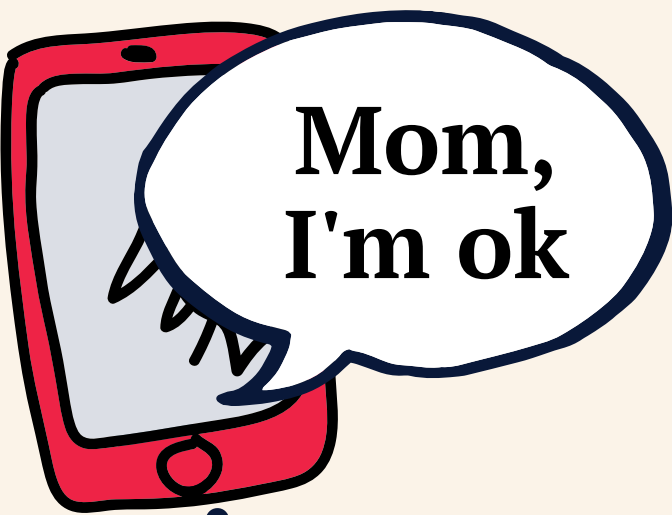
Lighting, elevators, and heating & cooling all continue to function, keeping our families safe.
