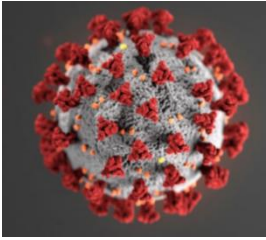


STATUS UPDATE ON COVID-19 IN CHEMUNG COUNTY

COVID-19 TESTING

There are positive cases of the Coronavirus in our community. These people are being isolated and closely monitored. Health Department staff identifies close contacts of these confirmed cases and notifies those that need to know.

You will be contacted if you are at risk.

Don't panic.

All positive cases are under quarantine or in the hospital.

Walking by someone or visiting the same place does not mean you've been infected.

The symptoms of COVID 19 include fever, cough, and shortness of breath. As more people are tested positive cases are to be expected. If you develop these symptoms call your healthcare provider. In the meantime continue to practice steps to stop the spread:

- Stay home
- Stay six feet away from people
- Wash your hands
- Cover your cough
- Protect those most at risk
 - People over 70
 - People with chronic medical conditions
