Temporary Underground Electrical Service (TUG) Agreement

A TUG is permission to install a meter connection as a future permanent service to a non-residential structure. This eliminates the need for temporary poles and allows for future connection of permanent power. The following guidelines are required to be met:

- Approval of a TUG inspection only allows for the connection of receptacles **for construction use** that are installed adjacent to the permanent electrical service of the dwelling.
- Electrical service equipment, including complete grounding electrode system, shall be completely installed.
- Surface behind electrical panel shall be prepared to inhibit water intrusion and lintel/bond beams/tie beams must be inspected and poured.
- Street address number must be installed and visible from street (temporary signage permitted).
- Additional conductors **shall not be connected** to the system until written authorization has been received by the Citrus County Building Division. Contractor must obtain an approved pre-power and/or electrical final inspection prior to connecting any additional loads.
- All electrical equipment shall be maintained in accordance with all applicable sections of the National Electrical Code during the construction process to include section 590.
- Should the permit become invalid for any reason, it shall be the duty of the contractor to notify the electrical utility provider to disconnect electrical service from the structure.
- Participation in the TUG program is a privilege to the contractor. The Citrus County Building Division has no obligation to issue authorization to any electrical utility providers to connect electrical service. This privilege may be revoked for any reason and the electrical utility may be notified to disconnect electrical service at any time.
- Failure to abide by these guidelines may result in disconnection of electrical service and may forfeit the contractor's future participation in the TUG program.
- The building and/or facility is not to be used or occupied prior to issuance of a Certificate of Occupancy. If Citrus County should find that the building and/or facility has been occupied before a Certificate of Occupancy has been issued, Citrus County shall have the unilateral right to direct that the electricity be disconnected without notice.
