

QUALIFICATIONS & ITEMS OF INTEREST

All Council Members/Mayor positions shall be elected for a two-year term each from the city at large.

A person serving on the Council is prohibited from serving concurrently as a member of the Planning and Zoning Board.

If a Council Member fails to attend three consecutive regular Council meetings without medical approval or an approved leave of absence the Member's seat will be considered as an abandoned position. *Texas Election Code 22.041.*

The applicant must be a resident of Meadowlakes for not less than one (1) year and be a registered voter with Burnet County.

According to Qualifications and Requirements by Texas Statute, the applicant must comply with the following provisions:

- (1) is 18 years of age or older;
- (2) is a United States citizen;
- (3) has not been determined by a final judgment of a court exercising probate jurisdiction to be:
 - (A) totally mentally incapacitated; or
 - (B) partially mentally incapacitated without the right to vote;
- (4) has not been finally convicted of a felony or, if so convicted, has:
 - (A) fully discharged the person's sentence, including any term of incarceration, parole, or supervision, or completed a period of probation ordered by any court; or
 - (B) been pardoned or otherwise released from the resulting disability to vote;
- (5) is a resident of this state
