RESOLUTION NUMBER 2016-009

A RESOLUTION BY THE CITY OF MEADOWLAKES, BURNET COUNTY, TEXAS, ESTABLISHING TENNIS/PICKLEBALL MEMBERSHIPS, TENNIS/PICKLEBALL COURT SPONSORSHIP, AND DAILY USE FEES.

WHEREAS, The City Council desires to establish a fee schedule for the use of the City owned tennis facility to satisfy the operational and capital needs of said facility; and

WHEREAS, The City Council has determined that it is in the best interest of the City that certain classifications, membership fees and usage fees be established.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MEADOWLAKES, TEXAS;

Section 1. Finding

The above and foregoing recitals are hereby found to be true and correct and are incorporated herein as findings of fact.

Section 2. Resolve

That the City Council of the City of Meadowlakes does hereby resolve as follows:

1. That a new prepaid usage classification titled "Tennis/Pickle Ball Membership" be established.
2. The amount of rates and usage fees as set forth in Exhibit "A" attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference reflect the prepaid usage classification, rates and fees reasonably required to be charged in order to recover cost incurred and borne by the City in providing for operational and capital needs of the tennis/pickle ball facility.
3. That the City Manager be authorized to sell a four (4) year court sponsorships in order to develop the capital needed to resurface existing tennis courts.

Section 3. Severability

The invalidity of any part of this Resolution shall not invalidate any other part hereof. The terms and provisions of this Resolution shall be deemed to be severable. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause or phrase of this Resolution should be declared to be invalid, the same shall not affect the validity of any other section, subsection, sentence, clause or phrase of this Resolution.

Section 4. Public Notices and Open Meeting



EXHIBIT "A"

Tennis/Pickleball Rates and Fees

Tennis/Pickleball Prepaid Usage Fees Other Rates and Fees for Residents of Meadowlakes:

\$600 per year if paid in one lump sum.

\$60 per month if paid monthly.

\$4 per person per court reservation (for 1 ½ hours for singles and 2 hours for doubles) if no monthly or annual membership has been acquired.

If a person/family is paying for an annual golf course package (not range access fees), a tennis/pickleball membership may be added for \$200 per year.

If a person/family is paying for a monthly golf course package (not range access fees), a tennis/pickleball membership may be added for \$20 per month.

Tennis/Pickleball Prepaid Usage Fees Other Rates and Fees for Non-Residents of Meadowlakes

\$750 per year if paid in one lump sum.

\$75 per month if paid monthly.

\$4 per person per court reservation (for 1 ½ hours for singles and 2 hours for doubles) if no monthly or annual membership has been acquired.

If a person/family is paying for an annual golf course package (not range access fees), a tennis/pickleball membership may be added for \$250 per year.

If a person/family is paying for a monthly golf course package (not range access fees), a tennis/pickleball membership may be added for \$25 per month.

A tennis/pickleball membership would grant access to both the tennis courts and the swimming pool.

Court Sponsorship

A total of five (5) court sponsorships will be available for purchase for the sum of \$5,000. Each court sponsorship would entitle to one of the five (5) existing courts to be name after the sponsor for a period of four (4) years.
