The enclosure as shown on the attached photographs is approximately 5 feet wide and 35 feet long including the entryway. The enclosure as shown does not meet the height requirement of 42 inches; however, the owner is having pedestals fabricated to increase the height to that dimension. The sandwich board signage and the awning support shown in the photographs will need to be relocated in order to maintain the required 5 foot minimum clear space for pedestrian traffic.




