May 2022

The Arbor Day celebration happened on Friday, April 29 at Menasha High School. Governor Evers joined us for the ceremony along with Rep. Lee Snodgrass, representatives from Menasha Utilities, UWO-Fox Cities, and Wisconsin DNR. A representative from Department of Workforce Development came to speak about the Youth Arborist Apprenticeship program. Following the ceremony, staff and volunteers from Jason's Tree Service and Heckrodt worked with Butte des Morts 4th Graders and Menasha High students to plant 25 trees on the streets adjacent to the High School.

RECREATION

Spring/Summer Preparations

Our summer registration is going strong with 66% of our programs already having one-half or more of their max capacity. AND, fifty-five of the 211 programs are at full capacity. It's so satisfying to see the interest in our programs and events!

Hiring continues for our summer staff positions. Fifteen Recreation staff and 27 pool staff have applied and there are still a few more outstanding job applicants. We'd really like to get three more lifeguards.

First staff training is May 17th. We have two lifeguard classes scheduled (first beginning on May 20) and a recertification class is also on the calendar.

We'll promoting jobs, events and programs at the Spring into Summer event in Appleton hosted by United Way on May 21.

Recreation Programs

Our last &Me of the Spring was held on May 10 with 13 children and their caregivers. We will be bringing this program back in Fall.

Spring Into Rec will be a part of BlueJay Fest at the High School on May 21st. We will have a sampling of our many opportunities this summer with great activities.

Our first Pickleball Instruction class is wrapping up next week. It's been well attended but weather hasn't been too cooperative.

Archery has begun and we have a new experienced archer leading our program.

Home Alone/Baby Sitting class was held on May 11th with eleven students learning skills to stay at home alone during their day off of school.
