
6. Menasha Farm Fresh Market




1 Mile Loop = approx 20 minutes

Library = 1/3 mile = approx 7 minutes




Grocery = 1/3 mile = approx 7 minutes




Pharmacy = $\frac{1}{2}$ mile = approx 10 minutes


Shopping / Restaurants = 1/6 mile = approx 4 minutes
