City of Menasha Lifts Safer at Home Order and Issues COVID-19 Recommendations

MENASHA, WI –Today we received new regional data related to the Badger Bounce Back Gating Criteria showing that our efforts to contain the COVID-19 virus are working. In light of these data, the City of Menasha Health Officer is issuing COVID-19 recommendations which supersede the order issued on May 14, 2020. These recommendations are effective as of 5:00 P.M. on May 15, 2020.
